

WALKALOOSA HORSE ASSOCIATION

Rules for Registration Video

1. Only one horse at a time- being registered-should appear on the video.
2. Each horse must be clearly identified by name as it is shown.
3. The horse must exhibit an intermediate gait for a sufficient length of time. No less than 15 – 25 complete strides to clearly show that this is a natural traveling gait for the horse.
4. The whole horse, including the feet, must be seen at all times; if the camera is too close to show the feet or too far away, or behind the horse and the viewer is unable to see all four feet hit the ground for every four beat stride, the video will be unacceptable
5. The intermediate gait must be of a speed faster than a flat walk.
